Dr. Lee George LAM is Chairman – Indochina, Myanmar and Thailand (and formerly Chairman – Hong Kong), and Senior Adviser – Asia, of Macquarie Capital (an international investment bank from Australia) since early 2007. Dr. Lam has over 30 years of international experience in general management, management consulting, corporate governance, direct investment, investment banking and fund management across the telecommunications/media/technology (TMT), consumer/healthcare, infrastructure/real estates, energy/resources and financial services sectors. Dr. Lam started his career in Canada with Bell Canada and Bell Northern Research (the R&D arm of Nortel) and in Hong Kong with Hong Kong Telecom (then a member of Cable and Wireless). He was then with Singapore Technologies Telemedia (a member of Temasek Holdings) and BOC International Holdings (the international investment banking arm of the Bank of China group) where he served as Vice Chairman and COO (and formerly Managing Director and Head of TMT Investment Banking Group) of Investment Banking Division, BOCI's core business. Until late 2006, Dr. Lam was President & CEO, and Vice Chairman of the Board of Chia Tai Enterprises International Limited (now C.P. Lotus Corporation), a publicly-listed member of overseas Chinese conglomerate CP Group of Thailand of which he was also a Senior Executive Vice President.

Dr. Lam holds a BSc in sciences and mathematics, an MSc in systems science and an MBA from the University of Ottawa in Canada, a post-graduate diploma in public administration from Carleton University in Canada, a post-graduate



diploma in English and Hong Kong Law and an LLB (Hons) in law from Manchester Metropolitan University in the UK, a LLM in law from the University of Wolverhampton in the UK, a PCLL in law from the City University of Hong Kong, a Certificate in Professional Accountancy from the Chinese University of Hong Kong SCS, an MPA and a PhD from the University of Hong Kong.
