In the late 1980s, out of his enthusiasm for British electronic music such as those from Joy Division, New Order, Depeche Mode, Eurythmics, Yazoo, etc, Mark chose to pursue his studies in the UK. Influenced by the strong music ethos in the UK and changes in the dancehall culture at that time, he had developed a keen interest in dance music.

Upon returning to Hong Kong, Mark embarked on his own work on music so that he could make more dance music for Asian markets. Recognising that he needed to absorb the uniqueness of Asian music, he went specifically to South Korea for a period of cultivation. Thereafter, Mark created a host of very popular dance songs which are at once spirit lifting and emotion driving. These songs subsequently showed up in the must-sing lists of the thriving karaoke industry.

Mark is a master in creating dance music that arouses elation in the audience. He has been invited to be the music director by major Hong Kong concerts while he also likes to compile dance music for singers to show off their dancing skills. He has been music director for the concerts of pop artists including Leon Lai, Kelly Chen, Andy Hui, Big Four, Justin Lo, Janice Vidal and G.E.M.
