Mr Fok graduated from Oxford University holding a Bachelor Degree in Economics and Management. He is currently the Vice President of Fok Ying Tung Group. The main focus of business is real estate development in Hong Kong and Mainland China, as well as operating various leisure and culture facilities such as hotels, golf courses and marina ports. The group remains heavily invested in the Nansha Free Trade Zone, a major port and developing district of Guangzhou, Guangdong Province.

Mr Fok also plays an active role in societal work, mostly focusing on youth work and sports development. He chaired the Hong Kong United Youth Association (HKUYA) between 2013-2015, one of the most established youth NGOs in Hong Kong, and is currently serving as the Vice Chairman of The Committee of Youth Activities in Hong Kong, as well as being a member of the Commission of Youth appointed by the HKSAR government. Events organized by these associations mainly include exchanges and internship programmes for Hong Kong students in the Mainland, as well as entrepreneurship programmes to inspire a generation of youth to actively chase their dreams and participate in building Hong Kong future.

Mr Fok also plays a role in sports development, having elected to serve as the Hon. Deputy Secretary General of the Sports Federation & Olympic Committee of Hong Kong, China; as well as being a member of the Major Sports Event Committee, and the President of the Gymnastics Association of Hong Kong, China. He has been appointed as the Chief de Mission to lead many delegations of young athletes to compete in the Youth Olympics both in Singapore and Nanjing.
