Bosco Law is the Deputy Chairman and CEO of LAWSGROUP, where he leads and oversees the Group's global operations and development strategies in Manufacturing, Supply Chain, Retail and Property Investments. Bosco also holds the position of Chairman at Laws Properties, a subsidiary of LAWSGROUP, and is responsible for strategic investment and project development.



Founded in 1975, LAWSGROUP has been one of the industry leaders in garment manufacturing and fashion retail for more than 40 years. Under Bosco's new leadership, the Group further expands its Supply Chain network outside of China, with new factories in Bangladesh, Vietnam and Myanmar, serving numerous renowned fashion labels globally.

In 2007 to 2010, Bosco acted as the Executive Director of the Group's fashion labels *ZTAMPZ* and *bread n butter*, where he brought in new visions, branding strategies and expansion plans. The brands successfully penetrated in the mainland China and e-commerce markets, and expanded to more than 100 Fashion Boutiques, Lifestyle Stores, Florist and Café around the world.

In terms of property investments, Bosco led and initiated a series of industrial building revitalization projects in early 2012, including Hong Kong's first revitalized Shopping Mall-cum-Office Complex D2 Place. The two malls feature dynamic event spaces and is recognized as one of the "Creative Clusters" in Hong Kong by CREATEHK. D2 Place also received "The Best Hong Kong Property Brand Award" at *SCMP Enterprising HK Brand Award* 2016, "The Best Refurbished Building – Silver Award" at the MIPIM Asia 2016, and "The Outstanding Developer Award in Industrial Building Revitalizations" issued by *Capital Magazine* in 2014.

Bosco is also committed to strengthening the Group's Corporate Social Responsibility & Sustainability, including a series of charitable causes and the support to *Fashion Farm Foundation (FFF)* – an NGO focuses on nurturing young local fashion designers and driving the development of Hong Kong Fashion Industry.

As of 2017, LAWSGROUP employs more than 20,000 staff, with offices, factories, retail shops and property investments around the world.

Prior to joining LAWSGROUP, Bosco worked for Citibank and fashion retailer *Bossini*. He graduated with the Honored Bachelor degree in Architecture from University of Toronto in 2001.
